History

The Twentieth Century Club was organized on February 15, 1900 in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Its original name was the Young Matron's Club. The Club's name changed to Twentieth Century Club in 1916. The club's original purpose was "child study and home economics", but was redefined as "the advancement of social, benevolent and educational activities".

The club's charter members included Mrs. J.B. Bren, Mrs. F. Watson, Mrs. F.L. Jarvis Mrs. William Folsom.

Club membership was limited 40 women. Meetings were held twice a month from September through May. Meetings were held at the home of one of the members. Meetings frequently featured music and lectures. The club was also active in civic activities including the Red Cross and local school programs.
