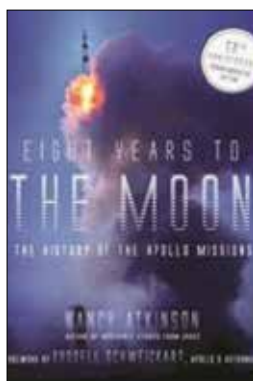
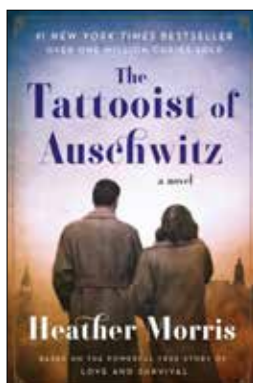

By Nancy Atkinson

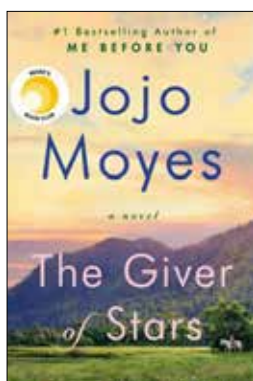
