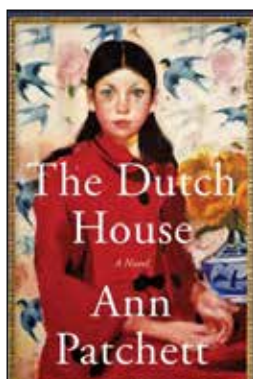
**The Great Unexpected****By Dan Mooney**
