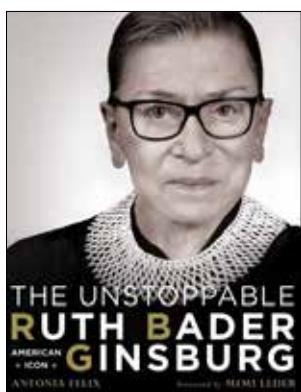

**The Unstoppable Ruth Bader Ginsburg: American Icon****By Antonia Felix**

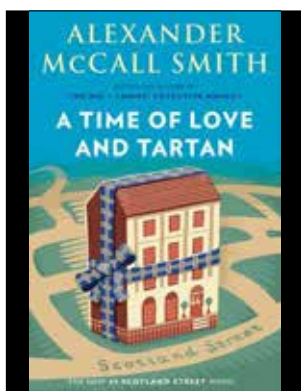
