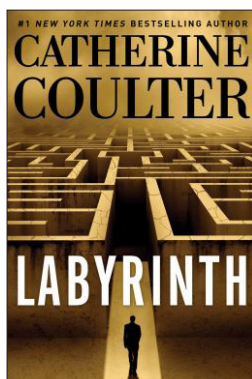


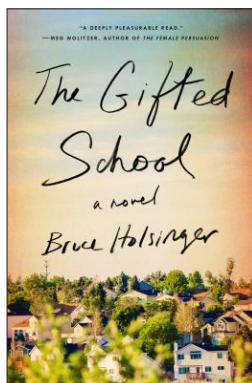
Reader Recommendations

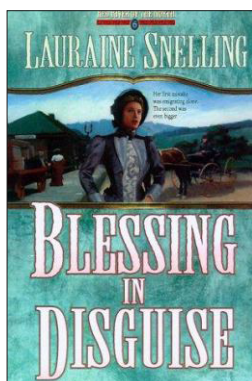
