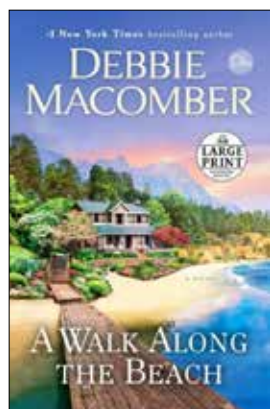

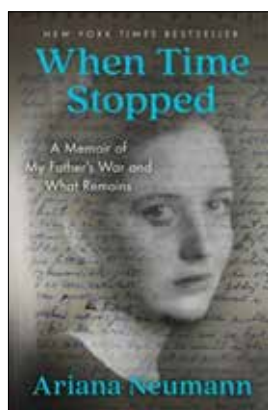
## Reader Recommendations

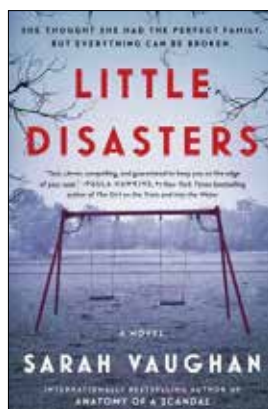
