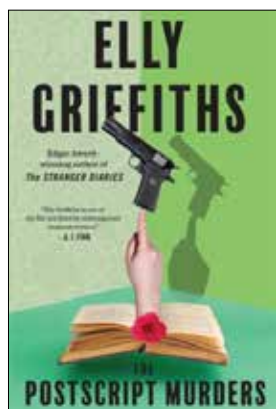

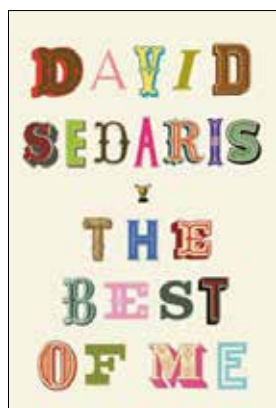
Reader Recommendations

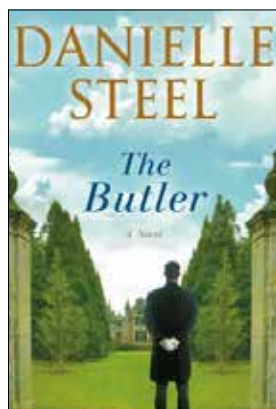
